

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The graduation requirements for high schools in the Sevier County School System are 28 (twenty eight) units minimum. In these 28 units, students are required to meet state required core units (for example 4 units in English, etc.). In addition, students must complete Personal Computing as one of these 28 units. A special education student may complete the student=s individual education plan (IEP). In addition each student (both special education and regular education students) must complete the three Gateway exams with the prerequisite minimum scores as required by the state. These exams include Algebra I, English II, and Biology. Students must be enrolled in four credit courses each term. Students will develop a four year plan that includes eight terms of attendance. A maximum of six (6) units of physical education may be used in meeting the 28 units required for graduation.
